Dear Camp Directors, School Administrators and Friends,

News and facts surrounding the topic of Coronavirus certainly have been increasingly alarming here in the US since March. Some of you (and some of us) have already been personally impacted by the virus. For many persons across the country with whom we have spoken to, we understand and empathize with the stress you have been under over the past few weeks. Please know we are here to help. 



Ensuring Safety In a Virtual Camp Setting

How does Drobots ensure campers are learning in a safe environment?

All Drobots instructors graduate from our mandatory training sessions. Throughout our training, we train our instructors how to maintain control of the session, manage appropriate language, and ensure the rules are being followed - exactly as our instructors would expect from campers participating in any on-location camp program.

All Drobots instructors have completed sexual harassment sensitivity training and preventive child abuse training. In addition, we conduct thorough background checks on all employees including but not limited to:

- Employment Background Investigations (EBI)
- State and National Security Check

All of our programs are accessible and hosted on a secure network, so only campers enrolled in a Drobots program, and those who adhere to our Code of Conduct, have the opportunity to gain access to our Virtual Camp platform.
